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as a young mouse living in the subway nib loves to hear about tunnel s end a beautiful yet dangerous roofless world filled with incredible wonders and mouse eating monsters one day nib decides to set off away from his dirty crowded home to find tunnel s end along the way he meets lola a girl mouse and together they navigate the long and dangerous tunnel just when they have given up hope they hear a small chirping sound can it really be tunnel s end

this resource is written for classroom teachers art education specialists childcare workers artists working in schools parents who home school their children and school administrators it can also be used as a university textbook for education students the book provides a framework for teaching art in a way that is integrated with regular classroom practice and mindful of current art curriculum outcomes although the book focuses on art for primary and middle school students from pre school to grade eight teaching art is also useful to art specialists at the high school level who are looking for new strategies or project ideas to add to their established secondary programs revised and expanded from the author s previous resource art illustration this resource integrates new developments in art education

encouraging writing guide for young readers which covers a whole spectrum of topics it succeeds in teaching them the nuts and bolts of the entire writing process from brainstorming their early ideas and shaping them on paper right through to hosting their own book launch yes kids will be trading witty repartee and bon mots with their fellow scribes as they get their literary game on and for when the dreaded writer's block kicks in kids can draw inspiration from their writing heroes by reading some short interviews with famous canadian authors and illustrators some of canada's finest including robert munsch m^olanie watt gordon korman and kenneth oppel agreed to answer 5 silly questions about their writing and included in this book a hilarious reminder that writers are funny people and writing is above all else fun

there's a huge world for students in grades pk k to explore and all around the neighborhood provides the perfect place for them to start teachers use the reproducible building fronts and vehicles to create a familiar neighborhood setting then let students' imaginations do the rest students add buildings from their own homes to fire stations to construction sites this 176 page book teaches social awareness in conjunction with a variety of concepts and vocabulary words that draw upon students' interests it includes 10 mini books 7 file folder games more than 60 reproducible patterns more than 80 literature links and a wealth of cross curricular activities that reinforce each new concept the book supports ncscs and naeyc standards

talking beyond the page shows how different kinds of picturebooks can be used with children of all ages and highlights the positive educational gains to be made from reading sharing talking and writing about picturebooks with contributions from some of the world's leading experts chapters in this book consider how children think about and respond to visual images and other aspects of picturebooks children's responses can be qualitatively improved by encouraging them to think and talk about picturebooks before during and after reading them the non-text features of picturebooks when considered in their own right can help readers to make more sense out of the book different kinds of picturebooks such as wordless postmodern multimodal and graphic novels are structured children can respond creatively to picturebooks as art forms picturebooks can help children deal with complex issues in their lives talking beyond the page also includes an exclusive interview with anthony browne who shares thoughts about his work as an author-illustrator this inspiring and thought-provoking book is essential reading for teachers student teachers literacy consultants academics interested in picturebook research and those organising and teaching on teacher education courses in children's literature and literacy
